Interview with Author Tina Westbrook "Letters From Alcatraz: 40 Years Later"

Author Tina Westbrook became fascinated with Alcatraz at the age of fifteen after watching *Escape from Alcatraz* which starred Clint Eastwood. Through the years she has done extensive research, learning the history of Alcatraz as well as life in San Francisco during the 1960s. Tina Westbrook was born in Chicago, Illinois in 1965. She moved to Birmingham Alabama in 1983, where she currently lives with her husband David and their family. Turnaround Media (TAM) recent had the opportunity to have a Q & A with Tina.

TAM: Where are you from?

TINA: I was born and raised in Chicago Illinois.

TAM: Tell us your latest news?

TINA: I'm out promoting "Letters" and I have been working on the second book in the "Letters" series and hope to have it available by January 2011.

TAM: When and why did you begin writing?

TINA: I began writing "Letters From Alcatraz" nearly two years ago. I started writing because I felt that if the story interested me as much as it did, then others would probably enjoy it.

TAM: When did you first consider yourself a writer?

TINA: That's a difficult question to answer. I've always loved to read, but never really considered myself a writer. Even now, with all the wonderful reviews coming in, I can't wrap my brain around it.

TAM: What inspired you to write your first book?

TINA: I was inspired to write "Letters" by John Catelli. His personal accounts of life in the 1960's and his connection to Alcatraz sent my imagination racing!

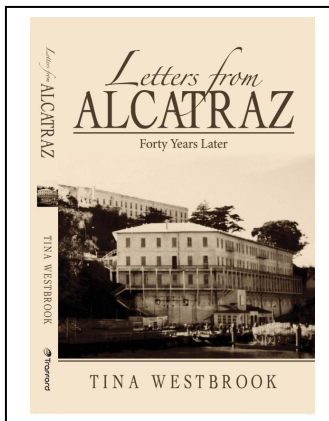
TAM: Do you have a specific writing style?

TINA: I know hundreds of writers and they are so dedicated to writing everyday and even set themselves a goal of "X" number of words. I have tried that and it doesn't work for me. I write when the feeling hits me. As for a style, I like to write about things that people can relate to, characters that people can identify with.

TAM: How did you come up with the title?

TINA: The title of my book "Letters From Alcatraz" is just that. The book is based on a series of email messages I received over the course of a year.

TAM: Is there a message in your novel that you want readers to grasp?

TINA: I hope readers will grasp the idea that we are all affected by the decisions we make in life, and there comes a point and time when we must come to terms with those decisions.

TAM: How much of the book is realistic?

TINA: "Letters" is filled with historical events and the book was inspired by a real person. There's a fine line between fiction and non-fiction. It's up to the reader to decide what they choose to believe is realistic.

TAM: Are experiences based on someone you know, or events in your own life?

TINA: Both!

TAM: What books have most influenced your life most?

TINA: I remember as a young child I couldn't wait to get my hands on a good book, and I'm still that way today. I've always enjoyed books that allow me to get lost in the story. If I'm reading a book and in my mind I can visualize the events that I'm reading about, then that's a good book.

TAM: If you had to choose, which writer would you consider a mentor?

TINA: If I had to choose I would say Nicholas Sparks!

TAM: What book are you reading now?

TINA: I just finished "Original Sin" by S.C. Lang and I am about to begin "The Second Virgin Birth" by Tommy Taylor.

TAM: Are there any new authors that have grasped your interest?

TINA: As I mentioned earlier, I have hundreds of friends that are authors and so many of them are incredibly talented. I'm anxious to read the upcoming sequel to S.C. Lang's "Original Sin".

TAM: What are your current projects?

TINA: Currently I'm out there promoting "Letters" and working on the second book of the series.

TAM: Name one entity that you feel supported you outside of family members.

TINA: That's easy to answer! A very dear friend of mine named Jay Stafford was a tremendous support while I was in the process of writing "Letters".

TAM: Do you see writing as a career?

TINA: I definitely see writing in my future! I don't know if I will ever be able to say that it is my career. I write because I enjoy writing. A career sounds more like work!

TAM: If you had to do it all over again, would you change anything in your latest book?

TINA: I would not change anything about "Letters". I feel it's an honest portrayal of one man's life.

TAM: Do you recall how your interest in writing originated?

TINA: Yes. My interest in writing originated when I met John Catelli. I've always loved to read, but for me writing only became interesting when I had a story worth sharing.

TAM: Can you share a little of your current work with us?

TINA: My current project picks up where "Letters" left off. The story takes a completely unexpected turn and hopefully readers will enjoy the ride!

TAM: Is there anything you find particularly challenging in your writing?

TINA: I write about a place that I love; a city that I love. If there's a challenge in writing I would have to say that it's allowing the characters to be who they are.

TAM: Who is your favorite author and what is it that really strikes you about their work?

TINA: Without question, Nicholas Sparks is my favorite writer. He has the ability to tell a story in a way that pulls the reader in.

TAM: Do you have to travel much concerning your book(s)?

TINA: My book was released mid-February and I have had to do a bit of traveling. The majority of travel will be this summer. I am already scheduled to be in San Francisco twice in June.

TAM: Who designed the covers?

TINA: I designed the book cover and the photo of Alcatraz was shot by me back in 1999. My design team at Trafford Publishing designed the colors of the cover as well as the font.

TAM: What was the hardest part of writing your book?

TINA: For me, the hardest part was writing from a man's perspective. I had to get into my characters head and I'm thankful I had a year's worth of emails to show me the way!

TAM: Did you learn anything from writing your book and what was it?

TINA: Yes! I learned that writing a book is a process. I can't speak for all authors, only myself, but I can tell you that I have to be in a certain frame of mind in order to write.

TAM: Do you have any advice for other writers?

TINA: I don't know if I'm qualified to give advice, but if someone asked me I would have to tell them to write everything down! If you have a thought, and when you're writing a book you will have millions of thoughts, write them down! Even if it's on a napkin! If you don't you will forget them later!

TAM: Do you have anything specific that you want to say to your readers?

TINA: I would thank my readers for sharing my interest in Alcatraz as well as San Francisco. I'm ecstatic that they have connected with the characters in "Letters"! That is the best reward I could have asked for!

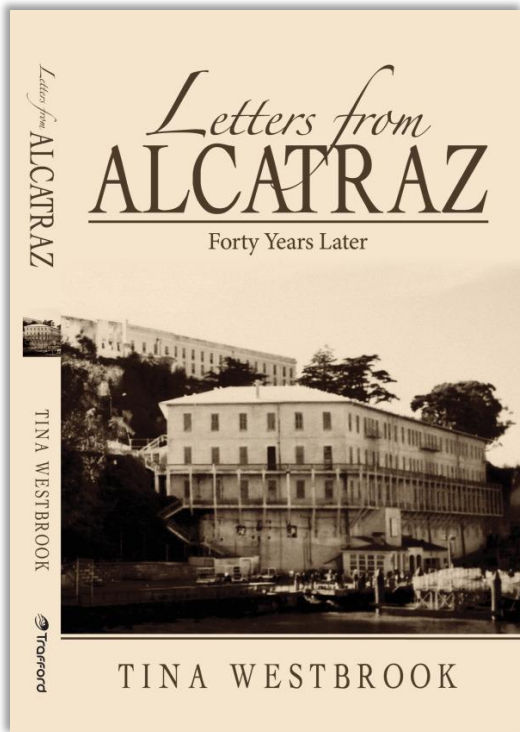
